

Adding to your existing will

If you have already made a will, you can add a beneficiary to it by means of a codicil. The example wording below can be used by you or your solicitor to amend your existing will.

An example codicil

In addition to any legacies given in my Will I give to Oxford Centre for Hindu Studies the sum of \pounds (or % share of my residuary estate/specific item) to be used for and I declare that the receipt of the Registrar or other duly authorised officer shall be a full and sufficient discharge to my Executors. In all other respects I confirm my Will and any other codicils to it.
